COURSE OVERVIEW

- + This 24 week (6 month) course staircases from the Certificate in Travel & Tourism. Students who have completed that course automatically meet the entry criteria for this course. This course has an international travel focus, and provides students with a comprehensive range of skills and knowledge suited to a wide range of exciting career opportunities.
- + International qualification module, with choice of:
 - University of Cambridge Career Awards in Travel and Tourism
 - Microsoft or computing modules leading to global Certification
- + Computing add-on option to upskill to Microsoft MOS Masters level
- + The course includes key units in international air travel, fares and ticketing and two computerised reservations systems. The inclusion of destination training on the key markets of the UK, Italy, South Africa, Thailand and Argentina provides students with product knowledge on the most popular outbound destinations.
- + The sales and marketing subjects are of real value in both outbound travel and inbound tourism jobs, and ensures ITC graduates skill levels meet industry standards.
- + The course includes a full programme of field visits and guest speakers.
- + This course cross credits to the internationally recognised IATA Foundation Diploma, and makes the course an excellent option for students with interests in working overseas.
