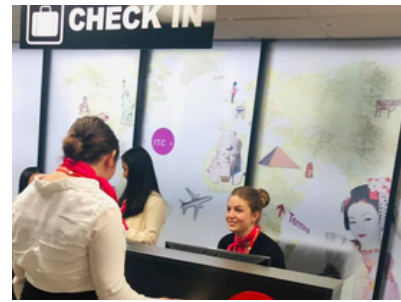

Part-time work experience

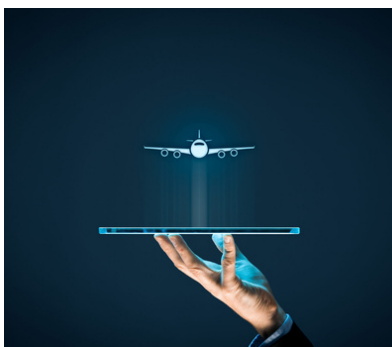
