Gain your level 3 & 4 qualifications

When you gain NCEA level 2, you can enrol on our NZ Certificate in Tourism or Aviation level 3 (20 weeks), then pathway to our NZ Certificate in Travel level 4 (21 weeks). You will need to get your learners license.
