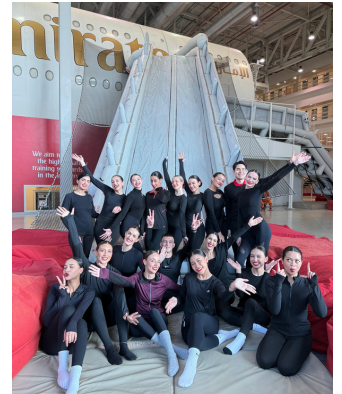

Students also experience the New Zealand tourism industry firsthand through industry site visits, enjoying attractions as customers, and participating in ITC-arranged work experience.

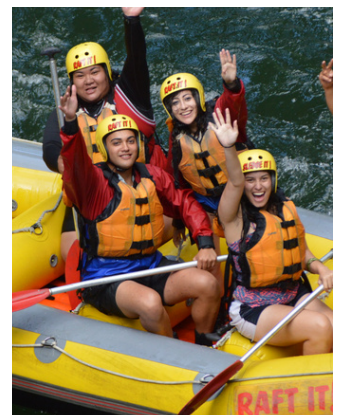


NEW ZEALAND DIPLOMA IN TOURISM AND TRAVEL LEVEL 5 (1 YEAR)

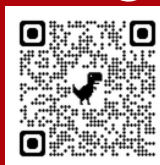

- Be 18 years of age or older;
- Hold a New Zealand or Australian passport; and
- Be currently enrolled in full-time study at a recognised tertiary level institute or be a recent graduate from at least 12-months (two consecutive semesters) full-time, study at a recognised tertiary level institute.
- If you are applying as a current full-time student you must have recently completed 12 months of full-time studies prior to departure. On campus or Disney.

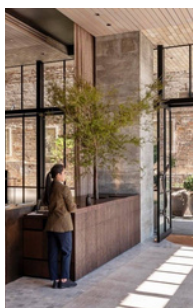
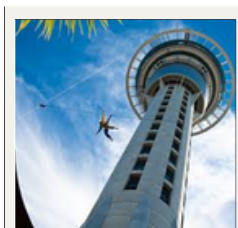

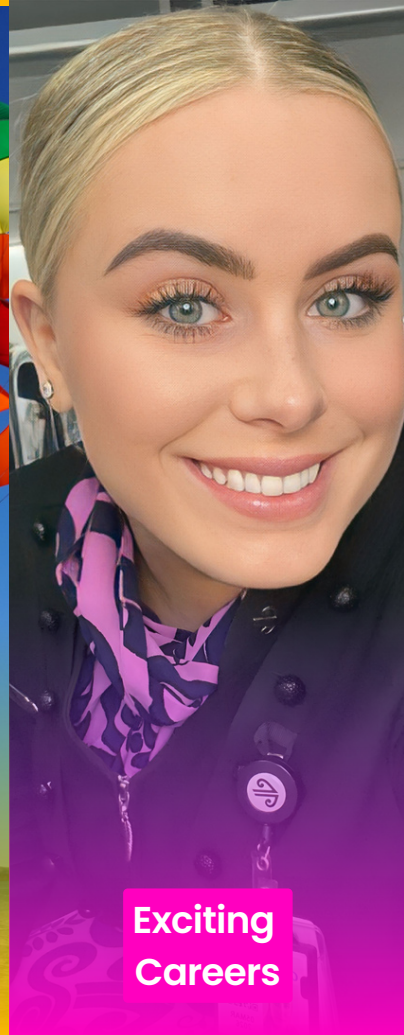
